A Message from the Head Athletic Trainer

Athletic Directors:

School visits for the spring season will begin the week of March 14th. Athletic Directors will be contacted to schedule their school visit. To be in compliance with board policies and state laws ALL athletic programs must be able to produce the following items:

- Signed and dated physicals for all student-athletes
- Signed assumption of risk, parental consent and consent to treat statements
- Signed Concussion Information Sheet (parents and student-athletes)
- Signed Sudden Cardiac Arrest Sheet (parents and student-athletes)

In addition to those items ALL coaches must have the following documents on file:

- Current CPR/First Aid Certification
- Signed Concussion Information Sheet
- Signed Sudden Cardiac Arrest Information Sheet
- Certificate of Completion for Concussion Education Course (dated within the last 12 months)
- Certificate of Completion for Sudden Cardiac Arrest Education Course

Athletic programs that cannot produce the requested items place the Shelby County School District at greater risk of liability. Students and coaches who do not meet these eligibility standards are not allowed to participate in SCS athletic programs.
