The Memphis Redbirds Community Fund, in conjunction with Major League Baseball, has made a donation to Pitch In For Baseball to benefit Shelby County Schools.

The donation will provide \$25,000 worth of baseball and softball equipment to help 460 students get on the field, benefitting 24 baseball and softball teams at 16 schools in the Memphis area.

Over the past 10 years, PIFB has donated more than \$5 million worth of equipment to 500,000 underresourced kids in nearly every state and 80 different countries.


