- 1. The basketball rules as published in the current National Federation rule book and any rules adopted by the NYSPHSAA and Section III will be followed by the conference.
- 2. Junior varsity games will start at 6:00 p.m. on week nights and 1:00 p.m. on Saturdays, with the varsity game to follow 20 minutes after the conclusion of the junior varsity game. If mutually agreed, the starting times may be changed.
- 3. It is recommended that an adult timer be used for all junior varsity and varsity games.
- 4. The home team will wear white or light jerseys, the visitors will wear dark jerseys.
- 5. Two certified officials shall be used for each junior varsity and varsity game. At least one certified official will be used for modified games.
- 6. Determining a divisional champion: the Center State Conference will recognize a champion in each of the three divisions. The team with the highest winning percentage of games within their division will be declared champion. Cross-over games do not count in the standings. In the event of a tie, co-champions will be declared.
- 7. Pre-Season Meeting There will be a pre-season meeting immediately following the mandated rules interpretation meeting. All schools should be represented at this meeting.
- 8. It is the responsibility of the teams involved to decide any questions of cancellation or postponement due to weather or other factors. If a game has to be rescheduled and the teams cannot agree on a date, the conference president will determine a date for the contest.

- 9. Selection of All-Conference teams The Center State Conference coaches will select a first and second All-Conference Team for each division. All players receiving votes that do not make the first or second team will be considered honorable mention. The voting process involves the use of a numerical rating system, described on the All-Conference ballot, to evaluate the players, with the ultimate decision based on a consensus of the division coaches.
- 10. Post-Season Coaches Meeting The post-season meeting will be a dinner meeting. Head coaches and staff are encouraged to attend. The purpose of the meeting is to select all-conference and exceptional senior teams, and for coaches to offer suggestions and make recommendations for future seasons.
- 11. Exceptional Senior Games There will be two exceptional senior games. Players and coaches will be selected by the league coaches.
- 12. Confirmation of Chair Coaches will determine their division representative at the post-season meeting, subject to the approval of the Center State Conference athletic directors.
- 13. The home team is to provide the visiting team with a minimum of 6 basketballs for warm-ups at all league contests in all levels.
