- 1) The current Section III recommended soccer rule book will be followed, including any variations adopted by Section III. We will be using the National Federation rules book.

Example: **Abandoned Games:** Per Section III rules the following should happen.

In the event a regular league game must be suspended because of conditions, which make it impossible to continue play, and less than one-half of the game has been played, the game shall be rescheduled from the point it was abandoned.

In the event a **sectional game** must be suspended because of conditions, which make it impossible to continue play, and less than one-half of the game has been played, the game shall be rescheduled from the **start** and replayed in its entirety. *Games abandoned after the first half are considered complete and becomes official.*

- 2) All Games will be officiated by two rated officials supplied by the home schools unless these are available through the assignor.
- 3) If a school has a regulation size field as per the rule book, this field must be used for the varsity match.
- 4) One timekeeper from each school will chair the official table.
- 5) Home teams are to wear white jerseys. If a conflict of jerseys should arise, the home team will be responsible for providing pinnies to the team in violation of jersey color.
- 6) The home team is responsible for providing game balls and ball persons as per the rule book (at least 2, preferably 4)
- 7) The length of the varsity and modified games will follow the Section III time allotment when these games are played on separate fields.
- 8) Games on Monday through Friday will start at 4:30pm. Games on Saturday will start at 11:00am, modified games at 9:30am. These games will be sent to the assignor; any changes must be made between the two schools with the home school responsible for notifying the assignor and the officials.
- 9) The home team must notify the official league newspaper, the **UTICA OBSERVER DISPATCH**, with the results of each league game immediately following the game. sports@uticaod.com This is mandatory, even if you have a different hometown newspaper.

- 10) League Championship – will be determined by points in all league games. The point system to be used will be: Win = 2pts, Draw = 1pt, Loss = 0pt. If two or more teams are equal in points at the end of the season, the tie shall stand and co-champions will be named.
- 11) Sectional representation will be determined by Section III qualification.
- 12) Teams should be allowed at least 20 minutes for pre-game warm ups. (Note – Officials – lengthy travel time for some schools to arrive at contests. Schools can't always be ready at start right at 4:30pm)
- 13) All coaches are expected to attend all pre-season and post-season meetings, as well as the rules interpretation meeting. If you cannot attend, please send a representative in your place. (dates and location TBA)
- 14) Each year at the post season meeting, divisional chairpersons' will be selected by the coaches and approved by the Center State Conference.
- 15) ***It is STRONGLY recommended*** that the team benches be at the opposite sides of the field from the fans.
- 16) First and second teams All-Stars for all divisions are selected by the coaches. Standings will help decide the number of All-Stars from each team. (Coaches discretion can alter the number of 1st and 2nd team All-Stars) In case of a tie in standings, teams share higher spot dropping lower number (ex. 1st, 2nd, 2nd, 4th)\
